SBA Low-Interest Federal Loans for Disaster-Related Damages

PHYSICAL DAMAGES - Businesses of all sizes and nonprofits/faith-based org. (Real Estate, Inventory, Equipment...) ECONOMIC INJURY - Small businesses and most nonprofits (Working capital, no physical damage needed to apply) Interest rates as low as: 3% for businesses, 2% nonprofit organizations. Max. loan, \$2 million

HOMEOWNERS:Up to \$200,000 for Primary ResidenceHOMEOWNERS/RENTERS:Up to \$40,000 for Personal PropertyInterest rates as low as 1.25%All loans have repayment terms up to 30 years

For businesses/homeowners, mitigation is available up to 20% of SBA's verified physical damage amount
